



Joseph Robert Chepega Sr.

February 5, 1934 - July 23, 2023

Joseph R. Chepega, Sr. of Eastampton, passed away on Sunday, July 23 at the Samaritan Hospice in Mount Holly surrounded by his family. He was 89.

Born in Swoyersville, PA, Mr. Chepega was a longtime Ewing resident before moving to Eastampton in 2006. He was a graduate of Trenton High School. Joseph was a Navy veteran having served on board U.S.S. Robert K. Huntington from 1952 to 1956.

He worked as a tool & die maker for General Motors Corporation in Ewing for over 36 years. Joseph was an avid bowler on a travel league, a lifetime member of the Ewing Elks, a member of the Happy Louie Fan Club, and someone who enjoyed tending to his vegetable garden every summer.

He was pre-deceased by his wife of 65 years, Dolores M. Chepega, in April 2022.

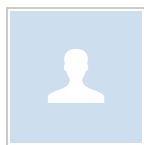
