Joseph F. Hare, III of Mount Holly passed away on Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at Fox Chase Cancer Center in Philadelphia. He was 60.

Born in Mount Holly, Joe was a lifelong resident and a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School and held several certifications from Rutgers University. Joe worked in maintenance for the Mount Holly Township Public Schools. He was longtime member of the AWPGA (Wire Haired Pointing Griffon) and involved in judging education. 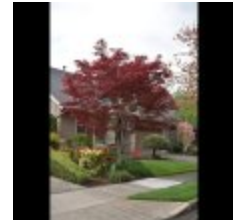

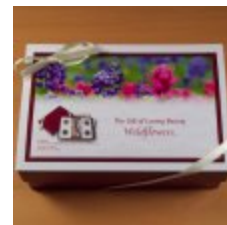
