June 12, 1924 - December 29, 2017

Joseph Edward Incorvati of Lumberton passed away on December 29, 2017 at the Samaritan Hospice Unit in Mount Holly. He was 93.

Joseph was born in Newton, MA on June 12, 1924, the oldest son of Ettore and Aurora Incorvati. He graduated from Newton High School and is survived by his wife of 63 years Lucienne; sons Joseph and Douglas, and grandchildren Ian and Ciara whom he adored; brothers Ernest, Alfred and Richard; sister Evelyn McGlory; and daughter-in-law Lisa Incorvati, as well as numerous nieces and nephews that he loved.

Upon graduating from High School, Joseph joined the Army and proudly served in the following Theaters of Operations: WWII - Pacific Theater, Luzon, Philippines, France, West Germany, Vietnam, Occupation of Japan and state side assignments. Joseph was in the Counter Intelligence Corp (CIC) serving with different assignments in the CIC. He proudly served 27 years in the Army and retired with the rank of CWO-3. After retiring from the Army, he went to work for PA Blue Shield for 20 years as a Field Rep until retirement.

He was a member of the VFW, American Legion, Counter Intelligence Corp (CIC), The Military Officers Assoc. of America (MOAA).

He lived in Mt. Laurel, NJ and later moved to Lumberton, NJ. He loved the area and was a great Phillies fan.
