Joseph P. Kovacs, of the Masonic Village in Burlington, died on Saturday, June 8, 2019 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 89. He was a long-time resident of Mount Holly. He was born in Passaic, NJ; the son of the late Joseph and Margaret Kovacs.

Joseph served his country for 9 years in the Navy and 11 years in the Air Force. He graduated with a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Maryland and a Master's Degree from Trenton State University. He was a school teacher and business department head at Willingboro School District. He was the President of the Board of Directors at the Githens Center in Mount Holly.

He was married to Carol (nee Salerno) for 67 years. While serving in the military, they were stationed in Lakehurst NAS (NJ); Jacksonville NAS (FL); McGuire AFB (NJ); Fuchu AFB (Tokyo, Japan); Carswell AFB (Fort Worth, TX); and Torrejon AFB (Madrid Spain). After retirement, he enjoyed traveling with Carol throughout the United States, Canada, and Europe.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his children; Kerry J. (Elizabeth) Kovacs of Morristown, NJ; Kathryn A. (Nicholas) Geary of Winter Park, FL; Dr. Jeffery P. (Karen) Kovacs of Washington Twp., NJ; grandchildren, Annie Geary, Timothy Geary, Nicole Kovacs, and Jonathan Kovacs.
