Joseph C. Tiver, Sr. of Lumberton died Tuesday, February 3, 2026 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 89.

Born in Moorestown, the son of Henry and Rose Tiver, Mr. Tiver was a longtime area resident. He was a retired Superintendent at Occidental Chemical and then retired from his “second career” as a bus driver for GST in Southampton.
