



## Joseph J. Jacobs

August 13, 1923 - March 19, 2013

Joseph John Jacobs passed away peacefully on March 19, 2013 at the Deborah Heart and Lung Center in Browns Mills, NJ.

Born in Wharton, NJ on August 13, 1923, Joe was a 23-year veteran of the US Air Force having served in the liberation of the Philippines in WWII. He continued his military career during the Korean and Vietnam wars, including two tours of duty in England and various postings throughout the US. Joe followed his retirement from the military with a second career with the US Postal Service, during which time he earned his Bachelor's Degree from Trenton State College. Active throughout his long life, Joe was an avid golfer, fisherman, soccer fan and builder of radio-controlled airplanes.

Predeceased by his wife, Mary, after almost 54 years of marriage, Joseph is survived by his daughters, Lorraine (Jim) Spille of Southampton, NJ and Gail Millstein of Marlton, NJ; as well as sons, Robert (Caryn) Jacobs of Gaylord, MI; Michael Jacobs of Falls Church, VA; and, Thomas Jacobs of Beirut, Lebanon. Joe is also survived by 7 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren, all of whom will miss him very much.

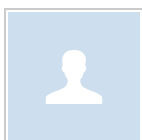
