Joy Ellen Lynch of Hainesport passed away on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at her home. She was 57.

Born in Mount Holly, Joy was a lifelong Hainesport resident and a Graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School. She earned her nursing degree from BCC and her BSN from Widener University and worked for 29 years as a RN on 4 Northeast at Virtua Memorial Hospital. She was a member of the Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing. Joy was a lifelong member at St. Paul Evangelical Lutheran Church in Hainesport. She gave much of her time to quietly helping others by volunteering with the food pantry at church and as a member of the Needle and Thread group. Joy also knitted scarves for the homeless.

Joy was the loving daughter of William and Joan Shibla Lynch of Hainesport and is also survived by her sister and brother-in-law Jill Lynch Hendrix and Ted Hendrix of North Carolina, her cousins, and her honorable sons Andrew & Quinton.

A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, September 18th at 11:00 am at St. Paul Lutheran Church, 910 Marne Highway, Hainesport, NJ 08036. Friends may visit with the family on Friday evening from 6-8pm and on Saturday morning from 10-10:45am at the Church. All guests are required to
