



Judith Cliver Wolfrom

February 19, 1947 - January 25, 2023

Judith Cliver Wolfrom of Springfield Township, passed away on Wednesday, January 25, 2023 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. She was 75.

Born in Mount Holly, Judy was a 1965 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School and a 1969 graduate of Albright College in Reading, PA. She then taught Home Economics at RV 1969-1975 and returned as a substitute teacher for many years. Judy enjoyed quilting and was a founding member and past president of the Berry Basket Quilters based in Medford. She also taught classes and workshops in sewing and quilting across the region. Judy started a book-and-quilt donation program with local libraries and enjoyed traveling and visiting with family and friends.

The daughter of the late Stanley and Anne Cliver, she is survived by her husband of 51 years, Glenn Wolfrom; her daughter Rebecca Lea Wolfrom of Palmetto, FL and her son David Douglas Wolfrom of Winslow, ME. She is also survived by 2 brothers: Jeffrey Cliver (wife Royce) of Henderson, NV and Gerald Cliver (wife Deborah) of Highland City, FL; and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral Services will be held on Monday at 11:00 AM at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Burial will follow in the Mount Holly

Cemetery. Friends may visit with the family on Monday from 10 AM – 11 AM at the Funeral Home.
