



## Kathleen Wagner

March 19, 1945 - July 2, 2018

Kathleen (Shannon) Wagner passed away Monday, July 2, 2018 in her residence. She was 73.

Kathleen was born in Burlington, NJ to the late Edward and Aurora “Dolly” Shannon where she attended Saint Paul’s Elementary School. She graduated from Burlington City High School in 1963 and later attended Rutgers University while working part time at Macmillan Publishing. Kathy was working for TWA as a reservationist at the Philadelphia Airport when she met her future husband, William Wagner. They married in 1969 and moved to Mount Holly a few years after. In the 44 years living in Mt. Holly, she raised two children, owned a small consignment store downtown and was involved with many organizations over the years including Sacred Heart School PTA, Mt. Holly Business Association, and Women’s Guild. She enjoyed crafting, going to Long Beach Island, NJ and making scrapbooks. Her favorite activity was spending time with her five granddaughters down the shore, hosting holiday gatherings and joining along with adventures like strawberry picking and pumpkin carving.

Kathy was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 45 years and is survived by her brother, Thomas (Lorraine), her two children Jon (Jessica) and Wendi Faul (Brad) and her granddaughters: Abigail, Kathleen, Shannon, Erin and Carolina.

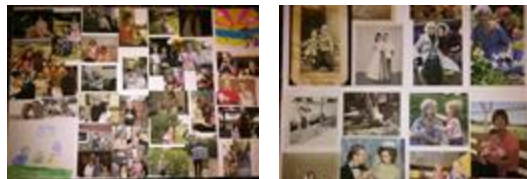
