*I'm sure she's going to ask that hers aren't too spicy and to please be sure to put an extra side of Ranch or Blue Cheese dressing and skip the celery!*

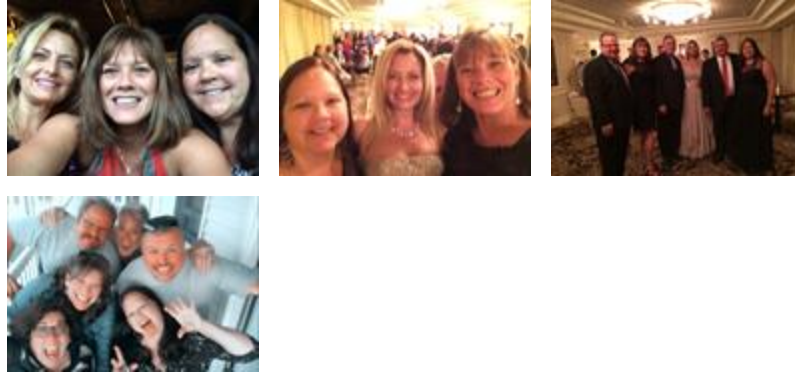
*I will miss you dearly my friend, I cannot say goodbye, just: Until we meet again.*
