He moved to Florida in 1990 to help his brother manage a restaurant and hotel but returned to funeral service working for Earl G. Hodges Funeral Chapel in Naples, FL where he worked as Operations Manager. David returned to New Jersey in 1997 and worked for several independent funeral homes and then for Stewart Enterprises as an advance funeral planning specialist. In May of 2003, David retired from funeral service and returned to Naples, FL.

He was a former communicant of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church in Mt. Holly and was a Eucharistic Minister and communicant at both St. Peter the Apostle and St. Ann Catholic Church in Naples, FL and was a member in the Third degree of the Knights of Columbus #4337.

David was a former member of the NJ State Funeral Directors Association, the Florida Funeral Directors Association. At one time he was an avid snow skier, hiker, swimmer, and bowler.
