



## Kenneth Mackintosh

September 26, 1939 - February 2, 2017

Kenneth John Mackintosh died peacefully surrounded by his family on February 2, 2017 at the Samaritan Center at Mt. Holly. Born in Moorestown on September 26, 1939 to Ryland Mackintosh and Ida Laura Farr, Ken was one of 15 children. He grew up in Jacksonville where he graduated from Jobstown elementary school and attended Rancocas Valley Regional High School. Since his marriage to Patricia Winzinger in 1966, he lived in Ewansville.

He worked for the Operating Engineers Local 825 as a heavy-equipment operator before being disabled. Ken loved hunting, fishing, bowling, watching football (GO DALLAS!), NASCAR racing, treasure hunting, and teasing every generation of children. Ken's favorite saying was "I'm going to shoot the Easter bunny!". He always had "God's" money in the driveway for the youngest children to find as well as a stash of candy.

Ken was a lifetime member of the Ewansville Fire House and a Horseshoe (slow pitch) Champion. Ken visited family in Georgia (Sharron and Lyman Prickett) every fall where he hunted, helped with the crops, and "took all the money" at poker.

Ken is survived by his wife, Patricia, three daughters, and a son-at heart: Ginger Thielman (Doug) of Hainesport, Vicki Mackintosh (Chuck Horning) of Palmyra, Deanna Drumm (Tom) of Eastampton, and Stephen Winzinger

(JoAnn) of East Windsor; as well as his grandchildren and great niece/nephews: Colin and Morgan Thielman; Mackenzie Horning; Kayla and Logan Drumm; and, Sarah, Gabriel, and Aaron Winzinger. Ken is also survived by one sister (Dot Stead) and two brothers (Bill and Jim). He also leaves behind two canine companions, Jade and Odie.
