Kevin W. Markel, of New Lisbon, passed away suddenly on Saturday, July 11, 2020. He was 52. Born in Mount Holly, he is the son of Robert and Kay (nee Schryer) Markel.

Kevin was a 1985 graduate at Rancocas Valley Regional High School. He worked for Burlington County Buildings and Grounds for 32 years. He was the past fire chief of the Magnolia Road Fire Company and a member of the Golden Eagle Community Band. He was an avid outdoorsman.

He is survived by his daughter, Elizabeth Markel; parents, Robert and Kay Markel; brother, Bill Markel; niece, Sarah Markel; and numerous cousins.

Relatives and friends may attend his viewing on Monday, July 20 from 10-12 PM at Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mt. Holly. Funeral services will be held at 12 PM at the funeral home. Burial will follow at Jesus, Bread of Life Catholic Cemetery in Mt. Laurel. 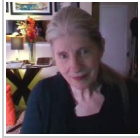
