



## Kurt Brenner

August 31, 1927 - January 21, 2018

Kurt Brenner of Lumberton, formerly of Mount Holly, died Sunday January 21, 2018 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 90. Born in Rastatt, Germany, Kurt moved to the US when he was 2. He served in the US Army from 1945-1947. Kurt graduated from Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken, NJ. He spent his career as an Engineer for PSE&G and after retirement did consulting work for many years. He enjoyed sailing and was a parishioner at Sacred Heart Church in Mount Holly.

The husband of the late Jeanne, he is survived by his sons Kurt, Paul (deceased), David, John, and Andrew; daughters Loraine and Carolyn; and a happy multitude of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
