June 10, 1932 - November 11, 2017

Kurt Wahl, 85, of Eastampton NJ passed away in his home, on Veteran's Day, November 11, 2017. Kurt was born in Schwäbisch Gmünd, Germany and came to the US at the age of 19. He retired from the US Army (Infantry), having served in the Vietnam War, where he met his wife of 51 years. Kurt also spent 25 years as a US Postal Carrier in Trenton.
