L. Jarred Corn of Lumberton, passed away suddenly on March 24, 2023. He was 53.

Born in Mount Holly, Jarred was a 1988 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School where he played football and baseball. He earned his Bachelors Degree from Trenton State College where he majored in accounting and played football. Jarred was a Certified Public Account and Managing Partner at Bowman and Company in Voorhees where he worked for over 30 years. He worked in the Governmental Services Department. He was admired by his co-workers, peers, clients and fellow CPA's for his technical abilities and the way he could inject fun and humor into even the most complicated accounting situation. Jarred was truly respected and loved by everyone he touched during his many years with the Bowman family.

Jarred loved Football, especially the Philadelphia Eagles. He was a staple at Veterans Stadium and Lincoln Financial Field for over 25 years and never missed a game. He enjoyed music, especially Nirvana and Mötley Crüe as well as many others. He loved to visit craft breweries and could be found at Spellbound every weekend with his family and friends. Jarred liked to dance, sing (often with his own lyrics), and play his guitar. He loved his dogs and their many nicknames. Jarred was always the most entertaining person in the room, often leaving everyone around him in tears from laughter. Most

importantly, he adored and cherished his family, especially his children. He was their role model, their biggest fan, their inspiration for hard work and shenanigans, and their fiercest protector.

The son of the late Lawrence Corn, Jr., he is survived by his wife of 29 years, Julie; 3 children: Timothy (Kiarra), Christian (Tarah), and Hayley; his mother Marilyn Phifer; his brothers Jason (Michelle) and Jody (Lauren); 12 nieces and nephews; and his father-in-law Ronald Lumby.

A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday at 12 Noon at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Relatives and Friends can visit with the family on Saturday from 9am – 12 Noon at the Funeral Home.
