



Lawrence A Gladfelter

October 14, 1938 - December 9, 2023

Lawrence A. Gladfelter of Mount Holly passed away on Saturday, December 9, 2023 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 85.

Born in Mount Holly and a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School, Larry served in the US Army and after his discharge from the Army, he worked for Two Guys Department Store and then moved back to Mount Holly where he worked as a longtime Sheriff in the Burlington County Sheriff's office. He retired as a Lieutenant.

Larry was very active in the local community. He was a member and Commander of the Mount Holly American Legion Post #11. Larry was also a member of the Friends of Smithville Mansion. He joined the group in 1979, became a Trustee in 1985, and served as President beginning in 2012. He was also instrumental in founding the Mount Holly Neighborhood Watch.

Larry is survived by his wife of 49 years, Mabel; a cousin Bob Severs of Lumberton and other cousins and many friends.

Funeral Services will be held on Friday, December 15, 2023 at 12 Noon at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Friends may visit with the family on Friday from 11am – 12 Noon at the Funeral Home. Burial will follow in the Mount Holly Cemetery.
