



## Lewis Brown

September 7, 1933 - September 2, 2011

Lewis Brown of Westampton died peacefully, Friday, September 2, 2011 after a long battle with diabetes-related illnesses. He was 77.

Born in Letohatchee, Alabama, Lewis faithfully served in the United States Armed Forces from 1951 until his retirement in 1974. He reached the rank of master sergeant, and served as a drill instructor. Lewis served in both the Korean and Vietnam Wars earning several honors including the Army Commendation Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation, and Expert Auto Rifle.

Upon retirement he worked in the financial services industry. A devoted husband, and father, Lewis was well-known for firing up some tasty spareribs on the grill for the annual Fourth of July picnic. He sopped his ribs in his special barbecue sauce using his signature four-inch paintbrush. Everybody loved “Big Lew’s” barbecue—with extra napkins of course.

Lewis enjoyed the simple pleasures. He enjoyed music and watching television, while kicking back with his beloved cats, Polly and Winston. He also enjoyed cooking fried okra for his granddaughters.

He was predeceased by his parents Emanuel Brown and Cora Hardy, and his sister Louise Algood.

He leaves his wife of 55 years, Jinnie Brown to cherish his memories. He is also survived by his sons, Curtis L. Brown of Westampton and Gary L. Brown of Lumberton; a daughter-in-law, Kimberly Brown (McLoud); three granddaughters, Kaitlin, Mackenzie, and Marissa of Lumberton; and a host of cousins, nephews, nieces, sisters-in-law, and brothers-in-law.

Funeral services will be held at 12 Noon, Friday, September 9, at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Friends and relatives may visit the family from 10:00 a.m. to 12 Noon at the funeral home. Interment will follow at the Brigadier General William C. Doyle Veterans' Memorial Cemetery in Arneytown.
