



Lewis W. Morse

September 1, 1919 - December 2, 2008

Lewis Morse, 94, of Mount Holly, former expert watchmaker and co-owner of Morse Jewelers, died Tuesday at his home.

A Mount Holly native, Mr. Morse graduated from Mount Holly High School in 1931 as the top student in business in his class. He then went on to attend Pierce Business School in Philadelphia.

While working for Western Union in Greenwich, Connecticut, Mr. Morse met his future wife, Doris. They married on January 15, 1940.

In the early 1950s, Mr. Morse and his brothers took over operations of Morse Jewelers from their father. Outside of work, he enjoyed gardening, deep-sea fishing, visiting the beach, playing cards, taking in races at the track and traveling. He was also an active member of Sacred Heart Church, the Elks Lodge of Mount Holly and the Knights of Columbus.

In addition to his wife of 68 years, he is survived by sons Lawrence, Michael, Daniel and Thomas; daughters Mary Linda Giberson and Ann Denise. He also leaves behind 12 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren, two brothers, and numerous nieces, nephews and godchildren.
