Linda L. Bauma, of Jacksonville, age 67, passed away on Sunday, February 1, 2026 at her home, surrounded by her family. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, daughter, sister, aunt, and friend.

Born and raised in Mount Holly, Linda was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1976. She worked many jobs over the years, but was most proud of her work at the Burlington County Board of Social Services office where she worked for over 27 years and later retired.

In her free time, Linda enjoyed reading, watching Hallmark movies, and playing games. She was probably the luckiest player at Yahtzee and would always have something to say at cards if she wasn't winning. She collected statues of angels and little children, displaying them throughout her home and garden. She is survived by her beloved husband of over 40 years, John Bauma, Jr.; two cherished children: John III of Jacksonville and Brigit Steinberg (Steven) of Voorhees; adored granddaughter Evelyn; and her siblings: Ruth Pallante, Roberta Scott (Robert), Joseph Pallante II (the late Viktoria), Marie Paolini, and Gerald Pallante. 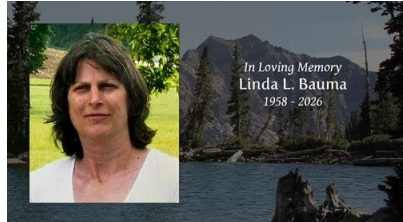
