Logan A Morris, 72, of Eastampton, NJ passed away Wednesday, February 27, 2019 at home after a short battle with pancreatic cancer. Born October 20, 1946 in Mt. Holly, one of three children of Logan and Elizabeth Morris. Logan was a 1965 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School and Trenton State College.

Logan is survived by his two daughters; Vanessa Puskar, her husband Dave of East Windsor, and Paige Shaw, her husband Matthew of Hainesport. He is also survived by his siblings; brother Bradford Morris and wife Anne of Nashua, NH, and sister Lynn Smith of Pflugerville, Texas. He spent the next 25 years as a vocational teacher at Pemberton Township High School before retiring in 2001.

Logan had a love for British sports cars and drove one up until the birth of his first daughter "when a back seat was needed." He loved fishing and hunting although the family never saw much proof. He enjoyed going to Philadelphia

Park race track with his family, having a few beers, smoking a few cigars and listening to the Blues/Oldies. Logan was a talented wood craftsman and the family will continue to cherish the many, unique pieces he created for his loved ones. Most of all, Logan enjoyed family gatherings, especially ones on family members' porches where he could embrace all the love and dodge an occasional Nerf bullet.

A memorial service will be held 1:00pm, Monday, March 4 at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High Street, Mt. Holly. Inurnment will follow at the Mt. Holly Cemetery. Relatives and friends may visit with the family from 11:00am until time of service.
