Lois Stein (nee Oxley) died peacefully in Burlington, NJ on February 1, 2017 at the age of 88.

Lois is survived by her granddaughter Christina Gurry (nee Costello) of Horsham, PA, her husband Liam, and their son Nicholas. She is preceded in death by her beloved daughter Marlyce Isacoff and her mother and guardian angel Helen Whitford.

Lois was born on September 27, 1928 in Paterson, NJ to Helen and Edward Oxley. She graduated from Eastside High School while running her own dance studio in Paterson. Lois was a Roxyette (forerunner to the NYC Rockettes) and toured for years as a professional dancer. She married John Stein in 1950 and they resided in the Philadelphia area. In 1953, they welcomed their daughter Marlyce Louise ("Marti"). Marti was their only child, and she, Lois, and Helen were extremely close. Her granddaughter Chrissi was born in 1980 and just welcomed her great-grandson Nicholas on Father's Day 2016.

Lois specialized in sales for the majority of her career. She helped run the family furniture store, sold Sarah Coventry jewelry, and worked in sales at Whitemarsh Memorial Park. Lois became licensed in real estate 40 years ago and worked at Holly Realty in Mt Holly, NJ for decades. She had an admirable work ethic and a passion for getting to know people. She often said that real

estate kept her young.

Lois was very social and known for her sharp wit, a love for colorful fashion, and an immaculately put-together look. Some of her hobbies over the years included sewing, puzzles, and reading. She became passionate about the Catholic faith and officially converted when she was 80. Lois was a dedicated member of Sacred Heart in Mt Holly, NJ and became a very active sponsor for RCIA.
