Lynn Marie Kosek-Walker entered peacefully into eternal rest on November 27, 2025 on the evening of Thanksgiving Day with her husband and children at her bedside after a 6 year battle with Parkinson's Disease.

Born October 28, 1960 in Philadelphia, Pa to Ronald and Romalda Kosek, she spent her childhood years residing in Pennsauken, NJ.

She was a graduate of Camden Catholic High School in Cherry Hill, NJ and went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree in Journalism at Rutgers State University, Livingston College in October of 1986.

This launched a very rewarding and successful career for her in television at New Jersey Network Public Television in Trenton, NJ. Her career as a television producer, editor, writer, and director earned her many accolades during her 25 year employment including 4 Emmy Awards for the production of programs such as, "The Race for Open Space," "Tight On the Spiral," and "Reflections of War," as well as 2 Cine Golden Eagles for "Turning the Tide" and "The Race for Open Space."

Her love for life led her also into personal achievements where she excelled as a Tai Chi and QiGong Teacher, Reiki Instructor, and Archery Coach. Her pastime was often filled with joys of wildlife photography with her husband at the Edwin B. Frsythe National Wildlife Refuge.

She loved helping people and preserving our natural environment and had a special place in her life for the Historic Whitesbog Village and its preservation.
