



## Margaret Jane Cline

March 19, 1936 - June 2, 2019

Margaret Jane Cline, 83, of Hamilton Township, NJ, passed away due to health complications on June 2nd, 2019. Jane, as she preferred to be called, was born on March 19th, 1936, to parents Dorothy and Howard McGuigan in Pemberton, NJ. Jane met the love of her life, Robert Cline, Sr., in high school, marrying shortly after she graduated from Pemberton High School. Jane and Bob settled in Hamilton Township where they raised their children and built their community for almost 65 years. Jane was always good with numbers, working for small businesses, accountants and for the state of NJ as an auditor. Numbers and money fascinated Jane in more ways than one, she could spend hours hunting for bargains at the local thrift stores and yard sales and on QVC. Born with an adventurous spirit, Jane enjoyed camping, road trips, and cruises, never turned down a chance to go to Disney World, and insisted on traveling to Mexico at 82 for Shaun and Sasha's wedding.

The focus of Jane's life was her family and friends. Jane took pride in remembering and making each person's favorite dishes, arriving to family gatherings with a parade of Tupperware. "Grandma" was perhaps the name Jane wore most proudly, welcoming every grandchild (and greatgrandchild) with a beautiful, hand-crocheted quilt, many of which will be displayed as part of Jane's memorial service.

Jane is survived by her husband, Bob, and all of Bob and Jane's children, grandchildren, and greatgrandchildren: Terry, Evonne, Brian, Liz, Shaun, Dana, Daniel, Lauren, Ali, Melissa, Anthony, Mason, Ellis, Charlie, and Jaxon as well as her sister, Pat, her son- and grandson- in-law Butch and Ken, her daughters-in-law Jenn, Gina, and Sasha, granddaughter in-law Jenn as well as many friends and extended family.
