Marie Nolan Buxton, a beloved mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, passed away in peace on Sept. 10, 2012 in Norristown, PA, at the age of 93.

Marie had a long career in public service that included serving as a Member of the Bergen County Board of Elections, and as State Committeewoman and County Committeewoman for the Democratic Party of New Jersey. She served as a delegate to the 1960 Democratic Convention and as an alternate to the 1964 Convention. She also worked for the Bergen County Road Department as Personnel Manager for many years.

Born in Dumont, New Jersey to Mary C. and Martin Nolan, she lived most of her life in Englewood and Oradell, New Jersey, and after retirement, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County, New Jersey.

Marie was pre-deceased by her loving husband of 64 years, James Isaac Buxton, a daughter, Elizabeth, and her six siblings Martin, Dorothy, James, Daniel, Julia and Patricia. She is survived by her three children - Mary, James Jr., and Ellen, six grandchildren – Jay, Daniel, Jared, Michael, Sarah and Ryan, and 7 great-grandchildren.

She will be deeply missed by her family and many friends.

A viewing will be held on Thursday, September 20, 2012, at Perinchief Funeral Chapel, 438 High Street Mount Holly, New Jersey, 2-4 pm, and 7-9 pm. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Friday, September 21st, 11 am. at Sacred Heart Church, 260 High St., Mt. Holly, New Jersey. She will be interred at Brigadier General William C Doyle Veterans Memorial Cemetery , 350 Province Line Road, Wrightstown, New Jersey, alongside her beloved husband.
