Marilyn L. Lintz died on April 16, 2018. She was 91.

Born in Boston, Mass. to James Lyman and Bernice Lyman (nee Locke), she lived in Lynn, Mass. and Washington, D.C. before moving to Philadelphia, Pa., where she graduated from Frankford HS. She married Robert Lintz in 1946, and they had three daughters. In 1961 they bought a summer home on Long Beach Island, which she lovingly shared with family and friends for the rest of her life. After Bob's death in 1978, she worked for Lawnview Cemetery in Rockledge until she retired at 75.

Marilyn loved to cook, collect antiques, garden, and arrange flowers. She volunteered at the Long Beach Island Museum and was an active member of Spray Beach Yacht Club, Spray Beach Chapel, and the Trevoise Horticultural Society. She relished travel, and enjoyed numerous trips abroad with friends. She is survived by her three daughters, Barbara Moore (Robert), Joanne Martin (Gerald), and Nancy Jones (Joseph), 9 grandchildren, 15 great-grandchildren, and by her sisters Bernice Cooper and Lillian Kelly.
