January 20, 1928 - August 4, 2021

Marion P. Hancock passed away on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at age 93. Beloved wife of the late Walter W. Hancock and mother of the late Betty (Hancock) Dobbs, she is survived by her daughters Lois (Hancock) Beauchamp, and Susan (Hancock) Roohr, and son Walter Jr., and their spouses as well as twelve grandchildren and nineteen great-grandchildren. Marion lived her entire life in Burlington County, growing up on a farm in Columbus and moving to Westampton Township after marrying her husband.
