



## Marion L. Heller

January 14, 1943 - July 20, 2019

Marion L. Heller of Lumberton, formerly of Mount Holly, died Saturday, July 20, 2019 at Virtua Health & Rehab Center in Lumberton. She was 76.

Born in Mount Holly, Marion attended Mount Holly Township Schools & was a 1960 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School.

She worked at Sybron Chemicals, Macy's Department Store and most recently the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of N.J., as the Department Secretary, retiring in 2016.

Marion was a Past President of American Legion Auxiliary, Unit # 11, 1969-1971; a Past President/BCALA, 1973-1974; a Past State President of the American Legion Auxiliary, 1985-1986 & Past National Chaplain American Legion Auxiliary, 1988-1989. Marion was also a member of the VFW Auxiliary #2692 & served as District #11 President, 1996-1997, Department of N.J.

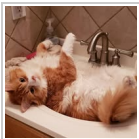

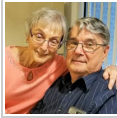

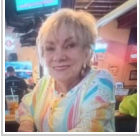
