



Martin B Csercsevits

February 18, 1947 - September 23, 2022

Martin B. Csercsevits, of Mt. Holly, died on September 23, 2022 at his home. He was 75 years old.

Born in Trenton, Marty grew up in Roebing, where he spent his formative years. He was a 1964 graduate of Holy Cross High School, and a 1968 graduate of the University of Dayton. He received his MBA from Southern Illinois University in 1973.

Marty was predeceased by his wife of more than 50 years, Ursula (Stringer), by his parents Joseph A. and Madeline C. (Swearingen) Csercsevits, and by his brother Kevin G. Csercsevits. Marty is survived by his children Joseph M. (Gina) Csercsevits, Dr. Beth (Mark) Wykle, and Jeffrey M. (Jennifer) Csercsevits, Esq. He is additionally survived by grandchildren Vincent and Jeremy Csercsevits and Benjamin and Elyse Wykle, his sister Gail Baxter Welch, his special nephew Thomas Baxter, four brothers-in-law, four sisters-in-law, and 21 other nephews and nieces.

Marty enlisted in the Air Force in 1969 and was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant the following year. He served proudly and was awarded an Air Force Achievement Medal, three Air Force Commendation Medals, three Air Force Meritorious Service Medals, and a Department of Defense Meritorious Service Medal. He retired from the Air Force as a Lieutenant Colonel on May

1, 1991 with 22 years of service.

From 1991 until 2011, Marty was employed by the NJ State Department of Health. He functioned as an Administrative Supervisor and retired in 2011.

An advocate of youth sports, he was head coach of Sacred Heart (Mt. Holly) recreational basketball teams, and assistant coach of their traveling basketball teams. He was also head coach of teams participating in the Greentree (Mt. Laurel) basketball program. He was also a manager and league president of the Sacred Heart Little League and manager and league president of the Mt. Holly Babe Ruth League.

Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Thursday September 29 at 10:30 AM at Sacred Heart Church (260 High St., Mt. 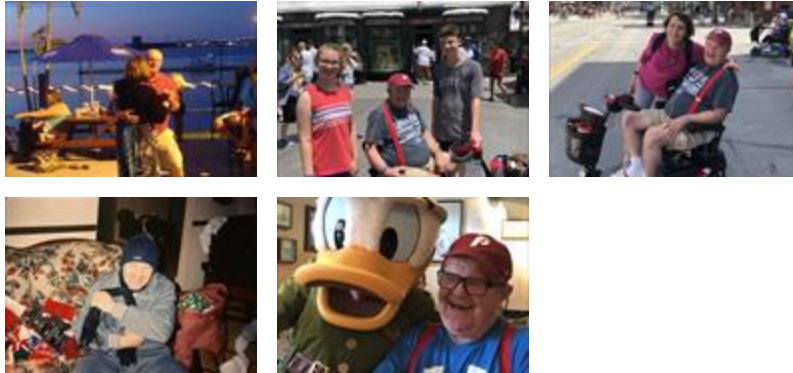

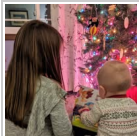
