Martin "Marty" D. DeGarmo of Mount Holly passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital in Camden. He was 65.

Born in Fort Riley, Kansas, Martin grew up in Mount Holly and graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School. He spent many years working at Yates Industries in Bordentown, but his greatest joy in life came from the love and laughter shared with family and friends.
