



Matthew K. Doyle Sr.

June 18, 1958 - May 2, 2022

Matthew K. Doyle Sr. of Westampton, passed away after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer on May 2, 2022 at Samaritan Hospice in Mount Holly, NJ. He was 63 years old.

Son of the late Joan C. (Crawford) and James B. Doyle, Matt was born June 18, 1958 in Trenton, NJ. He was raised in Levittown, PA, graduating from the former Woodrow Wilson High School in 1976 and eventually settling in Westampton, NJ with his wife and children. He worked at Emerson Process Management (formerly Fisher Controls) for over 30 years before retiring in January 2022. Matt was an avid Philadelphia sports fan and will be forever remembered for his witty sarcasm (“C’mon Shelly!”) and as a fine purveyor of funny nicknames for all those he loved.
