Maureen Tablas of Lumberton passed away on Sunday, September 2, 2018 at Virtua Health and Rehab in Lumberton. She was 77.

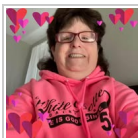

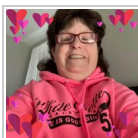
