Michael A. Koval, of Eastampton passed away suddenly Friday, January 25, 2013. He was 54. Born and raised in Hamilton, he had moved to Eastampton over 25 years ago. He was a Forensic Scientist for the NJ State Police and had worked as a Teaching Assistant for the University of Florida.
