I was so surprised, and deeply saddened to read this. Please accept my sincere condolences to you and your family. Colleen, you may have a very vague recollection of who I am, but I think we first met some 40+ years ago when Mike invited me and a bunch of our Southdale Kinney Shoe gang for a fish fry and beer keg party at your apartment complex. A few years later after Mike left Kinney’s for Susie’s, and you relocated south of the Mpls. Area, I made a stop to visit Mike and you briefly on my way to southern Minnesota on a personal road trip. I remember discussing your Siamese Fighting Fish you had in your aquarium, and later that evening, Mike brought out his old electric guitar to show me (I liked to play my acoustic at the time...no longer however). A forgot to mention that a few years earlier during my time at Kinney’s, Mike presented me with a 1972 Edina High School graduation gift, a bottle of Cold Duck (you may remember at that time the adult beverage drinking age was lowered to 18, so no laws broken there!). There were many times I can remember discussing with Mike, with his open ears, my future plans, my goals as much as what they were then, etc. and he often gave me suggestions and advice as an objective mentor would, or I suppose perhaps as a “big brother” might offer. Several years later when I relocated to Tucson to finish up at the U. of A., I connected with Mike on a couple of occasions when he traveled there. We lost track of each I guess after my wife and I eventually relocated to Northern Calif. in 1979, which is where we’ve been ever since. Colleen, I truly treasure the times I had in knowing Mike, albeit was so long ago, what he meant to me then and now in remembrance. And for pleasure of meeting you...especially with you putting up with that obvious big “fish fry mess’ in your apartment kitchen that we Kinney guys significantly contributed to.
