Mildred Gibson lovingly known as “Millie” – Beloved mother, grandmother, great grandmother, great-great grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend was born in Jersey City, NJ in 1933. Mildred was 1 of 12 children (6 boys and 6 girls) born to the late Otis Robinson and Laura Nunn Robinson. Mildred graduated from Lincoln High School. In 1952 Mildred married Lewis W. Gibson and became a “military wife”. Out of that union, they were blessed in 1953 with their daughter Icilda. Mildred enjoyed being a military wife, but that was not enough for her. She later chose to have a career of her own at the Deborah Heart and Lung Center.
