



Miriam Yoos Prickett

September 7, 1925 - May 24, 2018

A longtime resident of Lumberton, Miriam Yoos Prickett passed away on May 24, 2018 at the Masonic Village at Burlington Township. Miriam was 92. She was predeceased by her husband Phillip D. Prickett Sr. with whom she farmed in Lumberton for many years. They were blessed with eight children: Phillip Prickett Jr (late Kay), Janet MacCartney, Nancy Prickett, Carol Johnson (Howard), Linda Prickett, Paul Prickett (deceased), Faye Onorato (Silverio) and Joyce Alexander (Jeffrey). Also Miriam counted thirteen grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

When raising her children, Miriam participated in the Lumberton School PTA (was Past President and Treasurer), Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Saturday Day School teacher, and supported her children with dance, choir, music lessons, and sports. All of her life she was active in St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church in the women's groups and served on the church council and evangelism teams. She was also a Lutheran Brotherhood Representative. Miriam was a member of Farm Bureau Women and served on the Lumberton Planning Board and Zoning Board, was a member of the Lumberton Historical Society and the Nite-Outers. She was the recipient of the 1st Volunteer of the Year Award in Lumberton. For leisure Miriam enjoyed playing bridge and pinochle, doing fine needlework (she was a member of the Embroidery Guild of America), and traveling the world over, covering six continents. She was legendary for her pies, German potato salad, and Christmas cookies.
