



## Miriam M. Osika

October 22, 1916 - April 28, 2010

Miriam M. Osika of Marlton died Wednesday April 28, 2010, at Virtua West Jersey Hospital in Marlton. She was 93.

Mrs. Osika was born in Lynn, Mass., the daughter of the late Malcolm and Linda Johnson MacKenzie.

She was a graduate of Millersville University. Mrs. Osika began her teaching career in a one-room schoolhouse in Pennsylvania, and because of her husband's career as a field director for the American Red Cross, she taught in the Philippines, Japan, Germany, Africa, Italy, California and Alaska.

Miriam taught school in the Willingboro system from 1961 until she retired in 1980.

She was a member of the Willingboro Retired Teacher's Association and for many years was an active volunteer for the American Society and the American Red Cross.

Mrs. Osika was the sister of the late Malcolm L. MacKenzie, Lauriston E. MacKenzie and Eleanor M. Sleeper.

She is survived by four nieces, three nephews, and 21 great-nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held 11 a.m. Saturday at Wiley Methodist Church, East Main Street, Marlton, where friends may call from 10 a.m. until the time of the service. Interment will be held privately.
