Mordecai S. Haines Jr., of Westampton passed away Friday, January 16, 2015 at his home. He was 98. Born and raised in Mt. Holly he was a lifelong farmer and past board member of the Beverly Co-Op and longtime member of the Rancocas Friends Meeting.

An avid and long-time trap shooter, Mordecai was a member of the Amateur Trapshooting Association, Pine Belt Sportsman's Club, and the Pine Valley Gun Club, having won many tournament awards both locally and nationally, as well as becoming an inductee in the NJ Trap Shooting Hall of Fame.

He is survived by his wife, Esther (nee Ridgway) of over 70 years; a son, Richard Haines (Sandra); three grandchildren, Lori Nester (Lenny), Becki Haines (Teddy), Patti Ott (Kenneth); six great-grandchildren, Cameron, Connor, Damon, Sydney, Oliver and Tyson.
