Nancy E. (Betty) Schartner, 89, passed away December 10 at her home in Southampton, NJ. She had cancer. Nancy Elizabeth Sutherland was born in Ridley Park, PA on October 6, 1920. "Betty" grew up in Prospect Park, PA and then married her childhood sweetheart, John Schartner, in June 1941. They raised 3 daughters, and in 1970 she and John moved to Winston Salem, NC, where he helped open and manage a new Westinghouse plant. After 16 years and John's retirement, the couple decided to join old high school friends and spend their winters in the Florida Keys.
