



## Nicholas V. Sinopoli

October 25, 1954 - April 5, 2022

Nicholas Vito Sinopoli of Mount Holly passed away Tuesday, April 5, 2022. He was 67.

Nick was born in Newark, NJ in 1954 and was raised and lived in Mount Holly until his passing. He graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1972 before enlisting in the United States Marine Corps. After returning to civilian life he was a volunteer firefighter and truck driver for Dow Chemical before beginning his employment with the Post Office, from which he retired after 30 years of service.

Nick was a devoted father, grandfather, neighbor and friend to all, from working tirelessly with the class reunion committee, to making sure every Christmas card he mailed contained a lottery ticket just in case it happened to change someone else's life. He found so much joy in making people laugh, as anyone who heard any of his many creative voicemail recordings would attest to. Nick was so proud to be a Catholic, a Marine, and son of Mount Holly.
