Nina A. Mattson, of Hainesport formerly of Southampton, passed away peacefully at her home on Monday, December 14, 2020. She was 101. Born on November 29, 1919 in Terjarc, Finland; the daughter of the late Arnie and Alice Forsberg.

Nina moved to the United States at the age of 17 where she worked in New York City. She later moved to New Jersey with her husband (Karl). After raising her son, she worked at Rancocas Valley Regional High School managing the cafeteria for 33 years.
