



Norman V. Blantz Ph.D.

May 15, 1934 - January 25, 2015

Norman V. Blantz, Ph.D., died on Jan. 25, 2015.

The son of Norman V. and Edna M. Hollinger Blantz, he was born on May 15, 1934 in Lebanon, Pa. He graduated from Annville, Pa., high school in 1952 and Lebanon Valley College in 1956. Norman received his Master of Arts and Doctor of Philosophy degrees from the Pennsylvania State University. He taught at Myerstown, Pa., High School, Maple Shade School in Earl Township, Lancaster County, Pa., and Edison Junior High School, Westfield, N.J. He was Professor of History at Burlington County College, Pemberton, N.J., from 1970 until 1998, when he retired with the rank of Professor Emeritus.

Norman was a member of the Socialist Party, USA, and the Socialist Party of New Jersey, and was a presidential elector in 2000 and 2004. He served on the Board of the Burlington County, N.J. Historical Society and was a member of several other historical societies, as well as Americans United for Separation of Church and State and People for the American Way.
