Norman C. Jones of Medford died Thursday, June 19, 2014 at The Medford Leas. He was 90.

Born in 1924 at Mt Holly Hospital, he attended Lumberton elementary school, and graduated from Mt. Holly High School in 1943.

Mr. Jones played on the Mt. Holly Athletic Assoc. football team, was a founding member of the "Jersey Skiters" ski club, and an avid skier into his 70's.

He took over the family farm in Lumberton, growing tomatoes under contract with Campbell's Soup for decades, beginning during WWII. Mr. Jones took ownership of Lippincott Supply in the 1970's.

He was a resident of Vincentown from 1980 to 2008, when he and his wife moved to The Medford Leas.

He loved the seashore, especially his boats, his bicycle, and sunsets on his porch.

Predeceased by his wife of 61 years, Marion, he is survived by daughter Constance, son Joe (Nancy), and grandchildren Wes & Emily. He is also
