Florence Patricia “Pat” Bradley of Westampton, New Jersey—formerly of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania—passed away peacefully on October 28, 2025, at the age of 82, surrounded by her loving family.

Born and raised in Philadelphia, Pat graduated from Bartram High School, where she met her first husband, John William Greenewald. They married shortly after graduation and welcomed their son, John. Though their marriage ended early, Pat embraced single motherhood with strength and grace, working as a supervisor at MAB Paints in Philadelphia while raising John.

In 1979, Pat met the love of her life, Ira “Paul” Bradley, who had two children of his own. Their blended family grew in love and laughter, and after marrying, Pat and Paul settled in Burlington, New Jersey. Eventually, they relocated to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, where they enjoyed many happy years together until Paul’s passing in 1998.

Following Paul’s death, Pat returned to New Jersey to be closer to her growing family. She worked at McCollister’s Trucking until her retirement, always bringing warmth and dedication to her role. Pat found joy in dancing,
