Patricia Ann Wolfrom passed away Friday, November 16, at her home in Lumberton, NJ. She was 59 years old.

A lifelong resident of Burlington County, Patricia was born in Hainesport on February 3, 1953. She attended RVRHS with her high school sweetheart and eventual husband of 38 years, Stephan Wolfrom. They lived in Lumberton. Patricia devoted her life to family, spending much of her time to raising her four children, whose lives she was involved in from PTA mom to Brownie Leader to Marching Band Booster. Later in life Patricia worked for Acacia Manor where she served as a beloved social coordinator for its residents. 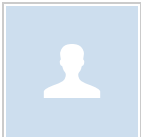

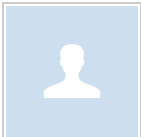
