



## Paul John Sherin

November 6, 1921 - December 14, 2018

Paul John Sherin of the Homestead section of Columbus passed away on Friday, December 14, 2018 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 97.

Born in Mingo Hollow, New York, Paul grew up in Montgomery, NY and served in the US Navy for 20 years, retiring in 1961 as a Lt. Commander. He later worked in hospital finance and administration for many years, eventually becoming the President and CEO of Zurbrugg Memorial Hospitals in Riverside/Willingboro, NJ.
