



## Pedro J. Sierra

May 9, 1924 - December 10, 2013

Pedro J. Sierra of Pemberton died peacefully on December 10, 2013 at home surrounded by his family. He was 89.

Born in Manati, Puerto Rico, Mr. Sierra was a longtime Pemberton resident. He was a retired Staff Sergeant in the US Army for 22 years during the Korean and Vietnam wars. After his retirement, Mr. Sierra worked for the NJ State Department of Transportation for 18 years. He was a Founding Member of Christ the Redeemer Roman Catholic Church in Mount Holly. He was also a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus and held the office of Treasurer.

Mr. Sierra is survived by his wife of 67 years, Luz M.
