



## Ralph M. Archer

November 16, 1930 - September 6, 2018

Ralph M. Archer of Burlington Township passed away at home with family on Thursday. He was 87. The son of Nelson and Elizabeth Archer, Ralph was born and raised in Columbus, NJ. He joined the US Navy in 1948 and proudly served 20 years. Ralph spent 7.5 years aboard the USS Worcester and was aboard the day she was commissioned in June 1948. He served in the Korean War going aboard as a seaman and leaving as a Gunner's Mate First Class. At the end of his career, aboard the USS Zellars, he proudly participated in a NATO exercise aboard the English cruiser HMS Berwick. He retired in 1967 and went on to work 30 years at US Steel in Fairless Hills, PA, retiring in 1998. He was preceded in death by his wife Helen. He is survived by his children Janet Lee Escalona and Kathleen Tidwell, four grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
