



## Ralph Snyder

August 4, 1931 - October 18, 2011

Ralph Snyder of Lumberton died Tuesday October 18th, 2011 at the Samaritan Hospice Unit at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 80. Mr. Snyder was born in McKeesport, PA. He was a retired Chief Warrant Officer in the US Army and served during Korea and Vietnam and received the Bronze Star Medal. Following his retirement from the Army, he worked for many years for the U.S. Postal Service. He was a member of Mt. Holly Lodge #14 F&AM and was a Past Patron of OES Chapter #147 Mount Holly and at the time of his death was Patron of Medford Chapter #287 OES.

Mr. Snyder is survived by his wife Shirley (nee Longstreet), three children: Melynde (Brian) Hitchens, Ralph Jr. (Patricia) and Kamela (Charles ) Sullivan, 6 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.
