Raymond A. Odell, Jr. of Eastampton, passed away on Wednesday, February 24, 2016 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 78.

Born in Hasbrouck Heights, the son of the late Raymond A. Odell, Sr. and Evelyn E. Odell, Mr. Odell was a longtime Mount Holly area resident. He was a retired Construction Official with Mount Holly Township. Ray was a member of the Mount Holly Elks, the Mount Holly Moose, the Mount Holly VFW, and was a very active volunteer fireman. He was Past Chief of the Eastampton Fire Department and a member of the Mount Holly Fire Department.

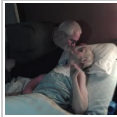
